# POSTDOCTORAL FELLOW/ RESEARCH FELLOW

Researchers in the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Program (ATSIHP) within the National Centre for Epidemiology and Population Health (NCEPH), Research School of Population Health (RSPH) conduct cutting-edge innovative and multidisciplinary large-scale research in areas across the social and cultural determinants of Indigenous health and wellbeing. We have a range of research projects that work with Indigenous communities to develop and analyse large-scale quantitative and qualitative data resources. Our approach across the program is to conduct research in partnership with Indigenous individuals, communities, and organisations, and to frame our work using a strengths-based approach, where possible. Research areas include tobacco control; the relationship between culture and wellbeing; cardiovascular disease; family and community safety and research methodology.

The Postdoctoral Fellow/Research Fellow will report to the Director of the Tackling Indigenous Smoking Evaluation, ATSIHP. This position will have a specific focus on the quantitative Tackling Indigenous Smoking Evaluation, and may also contribute to research across other Program areas. The Postdoctoral Fellow/Research Fellow will engage with a wide range of people across the university and external stakeholders.
