This position facilitates Cultural Heritage matters across South West Region through a range of activities and initiatives including those listed below.

- 1 Lead the facilitation of and progress actions from, Indigenous Land Use Agreements (ILUA's), working group meetings and other key meetings with Traditional Owners and First Nations peoples and ensure cultural sites are accurately identified, recorded and protected.
- 2 Develop and implement cultural heritage initiatives, policies, procedures and strategies, in consultation with Departmental staff, Traditional Owners, First Nations peoples and stakeholders.
- 3 Liaise with Heritage Officers and provide advice to Regional staff on historic heritage policy, conservation procedures, historic heritage management and protection and the legislation governing historic heritage.
- 4 Facilitate involvement of Traditional Owners in protected area management through formal and informal consultation and meetings and by supporting the development and implementation of projects relevant to park management and planning.
- 5 Represent the department on relevant Government and Community forums and specialist committees providing responses to public enquiries on the broad range of matters related to the protected area management across the region
- 6 Contribute to the administration of systems for consultation with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander groups on protected area matters.

This position is based in Toowoomba or Roma and requires the ability to operate 4WD vehicles in remote areas. Travel to other locations may be required from time to time and will include extended overnight trips and some bush camping.
