About the role

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide a consumer perspective on the College's development and implementation of the Reconciliation Action Plan.
- Work with the Reconciliation Action Plan Working Group to develop meaningful and practical strategies for reconciliation initiatives
- Ensure that the Reconciliation Action Working Group is aware of, and recognises the implications of, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community perspectives
- Act as a source of information and provide advice on issues affecting the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community that may be considered by the Reconciliation Action Working Group

Key Selection Criteria:

Please note: Due to the nature of this role, applicants are required to be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent. This is a genuine occupational requirement for this position, which is exempt under Section 14 of the Anti-discrimination Act.

Essential:

- High level of understanding and awareness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, cultures and issues
- Strong linkages and networks with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander groups and communities
- Ability to analyse issues and judge their effects on the relevant consumers
- Demonstrated knowledge and experience developing and implementing Reconciliation Action Plans
- Proven ability to engage with Aboriginal organisations, communities and individuals to foster productive and harmonious working relationships
