### About the role

The Executive Producer, INACA is responsible for overseeing the output for all NITV news and current affairs platforms. This role is responsible for:

- Overseeing and managing the production and studio presentation "live to air" of the news bulletins and current affairs programming to the highest professional standard.
- Work with the design and production teams to create innovative, informative and relevant graphics and animations to enhance the quality of individual news and current affairs stories, features and news bulletins.
- Determine, in consultation with the Executive Editor & Managing Editor, the format, structure and content of the NITV news & current affairs programming
- Ensure the highest professional standards of production and presentation of all INACA programming
- Assign and supervise the writing, packaging and editing of news items. Provide formal and informal feedback to staff. Ensure the highest standards of editing and writing is maintained
- Provide feedback to reporters/journalists/producers and other technical staff.
- As a member of the INACA management team, contribute to the effective day to day operation of the Department.

If successful, you'll initiate the production of compelling, insightful and relevant content that offers an Indigenous perspective to an Australian audience. You'll be accountable for maintaining and increasing our competitive position in the various platform markets across breaking news and through in depth, informative stories.

A key challenge is to effectively balance relationships with cross functional senior stakeholders while leading and inspiring a team in a deadline driven environment. The role requires a collaborative and collegiate approach.
