



## Aboriginal Health Worker Mental Health - Acute Review Clinic

This position is a temporary position up to 28.2.21 with a possibility of extension of contract.

This is a new Aboriginal Health Worker Mental Health position which has been established as part in the Help 2WIN team – Western Sydney Project in the Emergency Department (ED) and is located at The Sydney Children's Hospital Network Westmead Campus (CHW). The Aboriginal Health Worker -Mental Health position will form part of a team embedded within existing services to form an assertive multi-disciplinary team that provides clinical services and support to young people aged 12-17 years experiencing psychological distress, mental health difficulties and/or psycho-social complexity.

The SCHN Mental Health Service provides psychological care to children and adolescents at campuses at Randwick and at Westmead. This large mental health service provides assessment and treatment to young people with a variety of mental health conditions including anorexia nervosa, depression, anxiety, psychosis, suicidal ideation, selfharm etc.
