



ABORIGINAL PERMANENCY SUPPORT CASEWORKER

THE ROLE

Location: Liverpool, Sydney

Salary: \$70,000 + Super + Salary Packaging

The Permanency Support Caseworker is responsible for achieving best possible outcomes for Aboriginal children and young people and their birth families. This position will be responsible for triaging, case managing, streamlining referrals and maintaining ongoing collaboration with the Permanency Coordinators and DCJ to review and maintain best permanency outcomes for children and young people.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Undertake intense case management support to vulnerable children, birth parents and families
- Triage and refer families to services and to external services in-line with achieving their case plan goals.
- Act as an advocate for children and their families; attend case reviews and meetings as required for effective case management.
- Ensure that case plans are regularly reviewed, and facilitate the attendance of all key stakeholders at relevant meetings.
- Work collaboratively with DCJ to empower birth parents to address the worries in their SOPP and SARA and have their children restored.
- Access a range of relevant community resources, particularly in the areas of drug and alcohol services, mental health, legal assistance, income support, employment service providers, training and accommodation, family assistance and permanent housing options.
- Facilitate, support and supervise when necessary, contact between children and young people placed in care and their siblings, birth families and significant others in accordance with court orders.
- Provide high-level written reports and detailed updates to DCJ for court

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- Identify as Aboriginal
- NSW Driver's Licence
- Strong experience working with children and families
- Strong experience in child protection and OOHC
