- a minimum of three years (post qualification) work in primary health care as an Aboriginal Health Practitioner or Registered Health Practitioner (e.g. Nurse), at least part of which has been gained over the last 18 months
- an appropriate qualification and registration as a registered Aboriginal health practitioner, nurse or allied health professional.
- a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40116) or equivalent, and/or a Diploma (or higher qualification) in vocational education and training or adult education, or a commitment to undertake and complete the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment course during your first 12 months of employment.
- Aboriginal descent by parentage, or you identify as being Aboriginal and are accepted in the community as such. Applicant race is a genuine occupational qualification and is authorised under Section 14(d) of the NSW Anti-Discrimination Act 1977. Aboriginal applicants selected for an interview will be required to provide Confirmation of Aboriginality documentation at the interview.

1. Two referees with email addresses.
2. A claim for the position that addresses the key selection criteria and targeted questions.
3. Your current résumé, including evidence that you meet the specific requirements of the position.
