FIRST NATIONS CREATIVE DIRECTOR

Primary purpose of the role

The **First Nations Creative Director** plays a lead role in ensuring that First Nations voices, stories and experiences are appropriately represented across all Sydney WorldPride events, in particular the curation of the First Nations Hub.

The First Nations Creative Director will work closely with the Sydney WorldPride Festival Creative Director to ensure the artistic direction for Sydney WorldPride 2023 is successfully achieved.

Tertiary qualifications in arts, communications, business, design or other relevant fields

Essential requirements

- Proven experience in a similar Festival creative role, with hands on experience in the creative process, large
- scale event planning, and performing arts/music curation
- Outstanding leadership, interpersonal and organisational skills
- An understanding of the Australian First Nations values and protocols
- An understanding of local LGBTQI+First Nations communities
- An understanding of the LGBTQI+ communities
- Ability to work to deadlines.
- A willingness for local, domestic and international travel and working out of hours.

The role is initially Part Time (3-4 days per week) with the intention of becoming Full Time in mid-2021.
