### The Opportunity

Yerin is seeking a suitably qualified Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Individual to join our Ngaliya PSP team. This role will see you support child focused quality contact between a child, young person and their parent/family/kin who are in statutory Permanency Support Program Placements.

The Family Time / Case Work Support Worker General Responsibilities include:

- Provide a warm, friendly and culturally safe environment (as natural as possible)
- Observe the contact to ensure it is emotionally, physically and culturally safe for the child, and or young person
- Produce well written factually based reports that reflect the contact and interactions between parents, family and sibling
- Manage any distress, difficulties and unsafe situations as they may arise
- Provide child focused supervision of contact between a child and their family where supervision is the requirement of a legal order (when required)
- Assist in developing strong relationships with other providers delivering similar services and ensure staff attend these services regularly
- Work within a trauma informed framework

### Essential Criteria

- Minimum two years case management experience in PSP/OOHC, child protection or youth work
- Current NSW driver's license
- Current and valid Working with Children Check (WWCC)
- Satisfactory Police check

- 5 Using examples, demonstrate your ability to provide child focused supervision of contact between a child and their family where supervision is the requirement of a legal order and describe how you are a warm, friendly and confident in your approach with children and their families.
- 6 Outline your ability in producing well written factually based reports that reflect the contact and interactions between parents, family and sibling
- 7 Please outline your level of computer literacy and give examples of experiences and programs.
