**The Aboriginal Health Access Officer (AHAO)** is responsible for assisting the Aboriginal Health Access Team Leader with the development and implementation of strategies to improve the capacity of general practice and other mainstream primary health care providers to deliver culturally appropriate primary care services, increase awareness and understanding of initiatives to 'close the gap' in Indigenous health outcomes.

The successful candidate will have:

- Have a demonstrated ability to communicate sensitively with and to effectively engage with Aboriginal people and communities.
- Identify and be accepted as being Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander and actively participating within the community.
- Relevant experience in Aboriginal Health, health promotion, public health or community development.
- Demonstrated ability to:
  - develop and maintain effective relationships with key stakeholder's
  - influence stakeholder behavior and the adoption of change
  - consult meaningfully with the community
  - develop plans and set priorities
  - use a range of software packages including Outlook and MS Office, with Word and PowerPoint
  - work autonomously, under the direction of remote management, and effectively form relationships for collaboration between geographically dispersed team members
- Understanding of the primary health care sector is desirable
- Experience developing and delivering cultural awareness training is desirable
