## ASSESSMENTS OF PLACES FOR THE NATIONAL HERITAGE LIST

The Australian Heritage Council (the Council), as required by section 324JG of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, hereby gives notice that -

- (a) the Council is assessing whether the following places meet any of the National Heritage criteria (the place must have outstanding heritage value to the nation):
- Sydney Cultural Crescent Rock Art, NSW;
  - Mithaka Cultural Landscape, Qld;
  - Reconciliation Rocks, Qld; and
  - Cuttlefish Coast Sanctuary Zone, SA.
- (b) persons are invited to make comments to the Council on whether these places meet any National Heritage criteria and whether they should be included in the list;

### PLACES UNDER ASSESSMENT

#### NEW SOUTH WALES

**Sydney Cultural Crescent Rock Art:** Place generally includes a broad coastal crescent of land within the Sydney Basin between the coast and the Hawkesbury-Nepean River and stretching from Newcastle to Kiama, with boundaries to be determined during consultation with community and all interested parties.

#### QUEENSLAND

**Mithaka Cultural Landscape:** The sites are located approximately within the triangle that extends from Windorah to Bedourie in the northwest and Birdsville to the west. The site surrounds Betoota to the north, east, south and west.

**Reconciliation Rocks:** Location is part of lot 2 C1179109, Junction of Sherrin Esplanade and Adelaide Street, Cooktown, Queensland.

#### SOUTH AUSTRALIA

**Cuttlefish Coast Sanctuary Zone:** The Cuttlefish Coast Sanctuary Zone is in the Upper Spencer Gulf Marine Park, South Australia. It is off the western coastline of the Spencer Gulf, approximately 63km south of Port Augusta, 15km east, north-east of Whyalla and about 4km west of Point Lowly on the southern side of this peninsula.
