Overview: Working together with local and global partners, we seek to impel major shareholders to mandate systemically significant decarbonisation strategies. We are looking to add two carbon analysts to our climate team.

These roles will be offered for an initial 12 month period, with the expectation of extension.

The roles

Key accountabilities include:

- Providing carbon analysis on target listed companies, with up-to-date emissions data and climate risk analysis
- Undertake quantitative and qualitative analysis on company sustainability disclosures, industry emissions reduction benchmarks and company management and reporting on climate risk and greenhouse gas emissions
- Contribute to critiques of corporate strategy, solutions, methodologies, analytical frameworks and tools for investor audience, taking into account complex regulatory environments and stakeholder expectations
- Help investors shape the future of companies in a carbon constrained world, and help them meet their climate goals at the same time
- Support company, investor and proxy adviser engagement, including contribution to research, briefing materials, published reports and media
- Scan the horizon for relevant information through different sources including climate science, global climate initiatives, media articles, annual reports, investor presentations, and industry reports

About you

- Tertiary qualification, such as in engineering or environmental sciences, economics or accounting
- At least 7 years of relevant professional experience with at least 2 years' experience in a climate related position
- Knowledge of relevant climate change and energy policy, legislation, guidance and standards as well as a good understanding of the impacts of climate change
- Practical experience with energy and emissions reporting schemes such as Science Based targets; Net Zero Targets; Climate Active and regulatory schemes such as NGERs, RET and ERF
- Climate risk assessment and disclosure experience, including knowledge of the Task force on Climate-related Financial Disclosure (TCFD) Framework
- Knowledge of, and experience in decarbonisation approaches for key sectors (e.g. oil, gas, transport, cement, chemicals, steel) and climate strategy.

You are also a person with:

- a strong work ethic, and who would thrive working in a collaborative team;
- an alignment to ACCR's mission and values, including valuing diversity; and
- a desire to make a difference in the global fight to reduce greenhouse gas emissions worldwide.
