ABORIGINAL CULTURAL HERITAGE ASSESSMENT
INVITATION TO REGISTER AN INTEREST

Goodman (the proponent) proposes to develop a multi-storey warehouse at 2-8 Lanceley Place and 14 Campbell Street, Artarmon, NSW 20648. The site is located on two properties: Lot 14, DP233037 and Lot 15 DP233037 and is in Willoughby Local Government Area (LGA) and within the boundaries of the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council (LALC).

The proponent has submitted a State Significant Development Application (SSDA) to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) and is seeking approval of its proposed development under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.
