

Program Director, Aboriginal Culture and Healing



Bushfire Recovery Victoria (BRV) is a new permanent Victorian Government agency with a mandate to work directly with communities to support their recovery after bushfire disaster.

BRV takes a community-led approach to recovery, coordinating rebuilding and recovery and partnering with communities, governments, businesses and not-for-profit organisations to ensure recovery programs and services meet the needs of bushfire-affected communities, individuals and regions.

BRV is seeking applications from suitably qualified applicants for the opportunity of Program Director, Aboriginal Culture and Healing. Reporting to the Executive Director, Recovery Programs, this executive role is responsible for leading the design, commissioning, delivery and coordination of programs in the Aboriginal Culture and Healing pillar of recovery.

The role is a senior executive leadership position and will be offered for a fixed term of 3 years.
