This will involve a series of work-based placements within the health service and part-time study towards a Master of Public Health degree at a NSW-based university.

Essential Criteria:

Checks: Aged Care Check and Working with Children Check

Evidence of Diversity claim: Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander (pursuant to Section 14 (d) of the *Anti-discrimination Act NSW 1977*)

Selection Criteria:

1. Must be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent. An applicant's race is a genuine occupational qualification and is authorised by Section 14 (d) of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977, NSW*.
 2. Sound knowledge of social, cultural, political and health issues affecting Aboriginal people, families and communities and demonstrated understanding of the social determinants of Aboriginal Health.
 3. Minimum of three years' experience in health related full- time equivalent employment.
 4. Demonstrated high level oral and written communication and interpersonal skills.
 5. Demonstrated self-direction and ability to set priorities and manage competing deadlines.
 6. Demonstrated experience in the use of Microsoft office applications, including MS Word and Excel.
 7. Successful completion of a recognised undergraduate degree and/or ability to meet the admission requirements for the post graduate degree of Master of Public Health at a university in NSW.
