NSW Health has developed the *Safe Wayz Program* and *New Street Services* for children in NSW to experience safe, nurturing, and respectful relationships, and appropriate and healthy sexual development. The Sydney Children's Hospital Network (SCHN) provides support to these programs state-wide through specialist clinical advisors to which these 3 newly created senior positions will be added.

The *Safe Wayz Program* is for children under the age of 10 years who have displayed problematic or harmful sexual behaviours. It will be delivered through Local Health Districts by a range of existing NSW Health services and coordinated locally by local newly created positions including Aboriginal-identified roles.

*New Street Services* are for children and young people over the age of 10 years who have engaged in harmful sexual behaviours. Commencing in 1998 and now a state-wide network of services including an Aboriginal clinical workforce, has clinical support from SCHN.

These two programs combined are the Children and Young People's Sexual Safety Program (CYPSS). The program is committed to cultural care and inclusion in delivering prevention and response to PHSB of children and young people. This is an exciting and challenging opportunity to play a leading role in supporting NSW Health's workforce in delivering these programs.
