[YIRRAMBOI Festival](#) is Melbourne's premier biennial First Peoples Festival celebrating the vibrant living cultures and diverse contemporary practices of First Nations creatives. The Festival is guided by key principles of First Nations leadership, new work, visibility and dialogue, led by the Creative Director Caroline Martin. YIRRAMBOI shifts paradigms and perceptions in how to engage with, talk about, and present First Peoples arts and culture.

YIRRAMBOI Festival has been presented twice in its current biennial format in 2017 and 2019 with a third presentation planned for 2021. The year in between festival presentations is used to source local, national and international First Nations creatives. The development of new artists and content and the creation of pathways and opportunities are considered a critical activity of the Festival team. This arts and cultural Festival takes place over ten days and is delivered via a hub venue and additional events developed in consultation with the team at presenting partner locations.

The Festival team is seeking the support of a consultant to investigate and present for a six year growth strategy, including plans for financial and resourcing development.

The service will be delivered before 30 June 2020.
